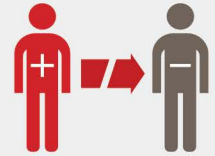

The approximate reduction in the risk of HIV transmission if an individual is diagnosed and linked to holistic treatment soon after infection.

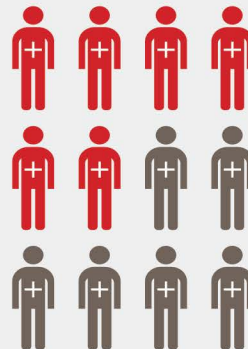
